We have now been operating this scheme at Broadbeach for a number of years with positive feedback from parents and carers with regard to efficiency and value for money. During the term we have reviewed the scheme and believe we can continue the program into 2020 without any fee increase.

The P&C Association has endorsed the SRS for 2020 at \$265.00 per student. The information brochure outlines the inclusions which I am sure you will agree represents excellent value for money. Given the purchasing power of the school we are able to negotiate significant bulk discounts, particularly in the area of online programs and textbooks. As an example, the parent/carer cost of annual single user licences for Mathletics (\$99.00), Maths Online (\$197.00) and Literacy Planet (\$95.00) exceed \$300.00. As such I feel our SRS offers exceptional value for families.

In preparation for the rollout of the 2020 SRS, **our computer finance package automatically generates an invoice for all students which will be emailed to your nominated email address.** No payment is required at this time however payments can be made on receipt of the invoice with the balance due by Friday 28 February 2020.

Please note, should you not wish to participate in the SRS, this invoice will be credited when you return the Participation Agreement Form with the **NO** box ticked.

To ensure instruction commences from the first day of the school year it is important that students have their stationery, online programs, textbooks and workbooks from the first day of school. As such **it is critical that you return your Participation Agreement Form to the finance window by Friday 08 November, indicating if you will or will not participate in the SRS.** This will allow us to finalise procurement for the start of the school year with starter packs issued to students on the first day of school.

This year we have much to celebrate having once again achieved outstanding NAPLAN results. I attribute this success to the quality of our teaching, the quality of our programs and the quality of the resources we provide.

I commend the SRS to you and look forward to your participation in 2020.
