

The Broadbeach Independent Public School uniform policy reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instils recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community, and assists in developing pride in representing their school. Our uniform policy is consistent with health and safety and anti-discrimination legislation. Broadbeach State School dress code offers gender neutral uniform options for all students.

The school colours are purple, white and black. The **wearing of the school uniform is compulsory** and is a collective responsibility (parents, students and staff).

Students are required to wear correct school uniform every day unless there is a specific uniform free day. The Broadbeach Independent Public School dress code is outlined below.

Formal Dress Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purple and white checked dress shirt • Plain black school shorts / skorts / skirt • Logos, stripes and images are not permitted on 'non' uniform items and must be of similar style and length as school uniform
Sports Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purple polo shirt • Plain black school shorts / skorts • Logos, stripes and images are not permitted on 'non' uniform items and must be of similar style and length as school uniform
Winter Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School jumper purchased from our uniform shop or a plain black jumper (No hoods or logos). These can be purchased at many department stores. • Hooded jumpers are not permitted as they breach Work Place Health and Safety requirements in the playground. • Plain black long pants (no logos) are acceptable during cooler months. • Leggings / Opaque coloured stockings must only be worn under skirts / skorts
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plain black sneakers / plain black leather shoes • White socks • If wearing stockings, socks are not necessary
Sun Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School broad brimmed hat must be worn during PE lessons, break times or other scheduled activities outside of the classroom • Sunscreen
Hair	<p>Broadbeach State School students impress with who they are and what they do, not with which they adorn their bodies. In particular, the following are applicable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair extensions, severe head shaving, partial head shaving, severe undercutting, streaking, other than natural colours, hair dying of unnatural, bright or fluorescent colours are not acceptable. • Medium to long hair must be tied up. • Small purple, black or white hair accessories are permitted.
Jewellery	<p>Acceptable items:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Studs or Sleepers - maximum of two earrings per lobe • A watch (smart watches are not to be utilised between 8:45am and 3pm) • Cultural / Religious / Medical jewellery (Should your child be required to wear an item for cultural, religious or medical reasons, please provide your written consent to your class teacher / Administration) <p>Decorative jewellery is not permitted at school.</p> <p>Please be aware that items worn around the neck and/or wrist present a possible safety risk in the playground and/or Physical Education lessons.</p>
Other	<p>To avoid students drawing unnecessary attention to themselves, being victimised or otherwise distracted from their studies, the following are also considered inappropriate for students and not permitted at Broadbeach State School.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nail polish • False / Manicured nails • Make up • Visible stick on tattoos
