This funding will be used to

- Provide additional human resources to support needs of diverse learners e.g. Speech and guidance
- Meet Year 3 NAPLAN Upper 2 Band targets: 70% in reading, writing, spelling, grammar and punctuation and numeracy.
- Meet Year 5 NAPLAN Upper 2 Band targets: 50% in reading, 30% in writing, 50% in spelling, 50% in grammar and punctuation and 50% in numeracy.
- Fund the precise identification, design, delivery, measurement and recording of targeted intervention for exceptional students.
- Refine the “Healthy Minds” program resources to ensure all students have the tools of self-regulation and develop in all aspects of the “You Can Do It!” program.
- Fund strategies to attain attendance target of 95%

Our initiatives include

- Employment of specially trained paraprofessionals to deliver programs targeted at student need.
- Employ a Support Program Coordinator to deploy resources to meet the identified student needs.
- Maintain the employment of English as a Second Language or Dialect (EAL/D) teacher to oversee and coordinate the deployment of resources.
- Fund subscriptions to Direct Instruction programs to assist EAL/D students.
- Maintaining staffing for Academy to deliver extension in mathematics and writing.
- Purchase of resources to support delivery of high-yield programs.
- Fund release time for Year Level Coordinators to refine curriculum plans.
- Train all relief teachers and teacher aides in the school’s signature practices.
- Provide Heads of Sub-school with time to release teachers for coaching.
- Applying collegial engagement plan to ensure fidelity in delivery of pedagogical framework.
