This funding will be used to

- Create and deliver Social Emotional Learning lessons throughout the school.
- Increase or maintain the percentage of Year 3 and Year 5 students above NAPLAN National Minimum Standard to 100% in reading; writing; spelling; grammar and punctuation; and numeracy.
- Maintain the percentage of Year 3 students in the upper two bands in NAPLAN above 70% in reading
- Maintain the percentage of Year 3 students in the upper two bands to above 80% in writing; 70% in spelling; 75% in grammar and punctuation; and 70% in numeracy.
- Maintain the percentage of Year 5 students in the upper two bands in NAPLAN to above 50% in reading; 30% in writing; and 40% in numeracy; above 50% in spelling and grammar and punctuation.
- Improve the precision of identification, design, delivery, measurement and recording of targeted intervention for exceptional students
- 95% attendance rate.

- Supporting the functions of four Heads of Sub-School and Head of Special Education and Targeted
