What is the eBooks Digital Library?

The **eBooks Digital Library** contains over 45,000 eBooks and audiobooks, including fiction and nonfiction reading material for students, compatible on almost any device. The collection includes easy readers, comic and graphic novels, science fiction, fantasy, and teacher resources.

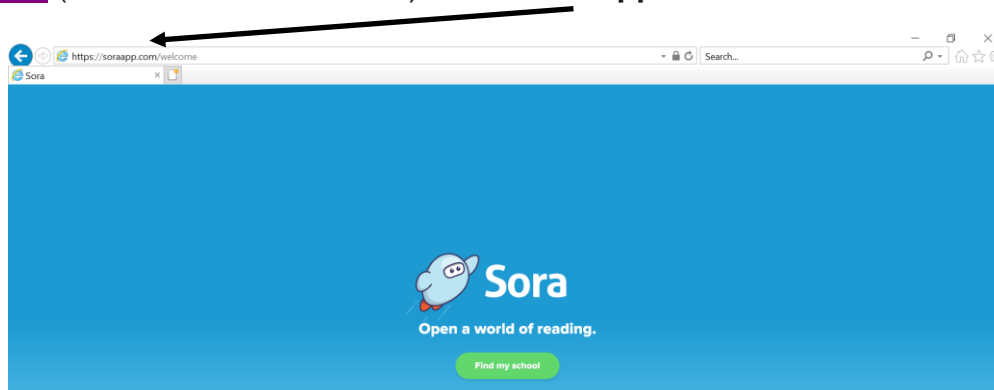
Students can access the eBooks Digital Library in two ways:

- Via the (free) [Sora](#) app for smart devices

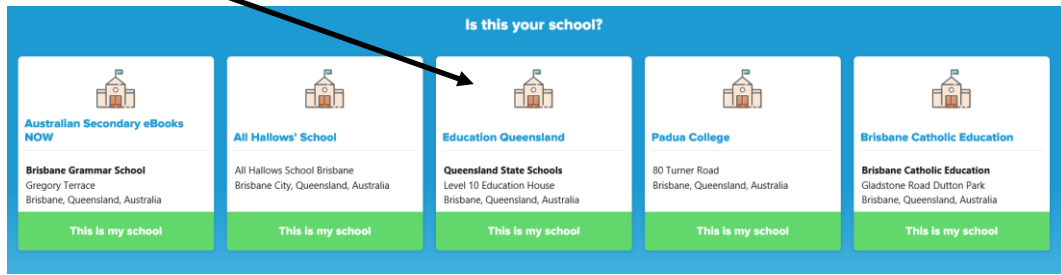

How do I access the eBooks service on a LAPTOP or in a web browser?

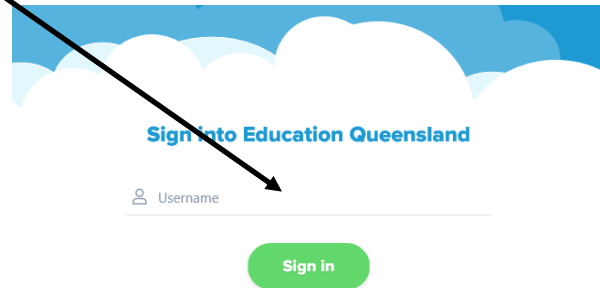
1. [Open Sora](#) (works best with Chrome) - www.soraapp.com



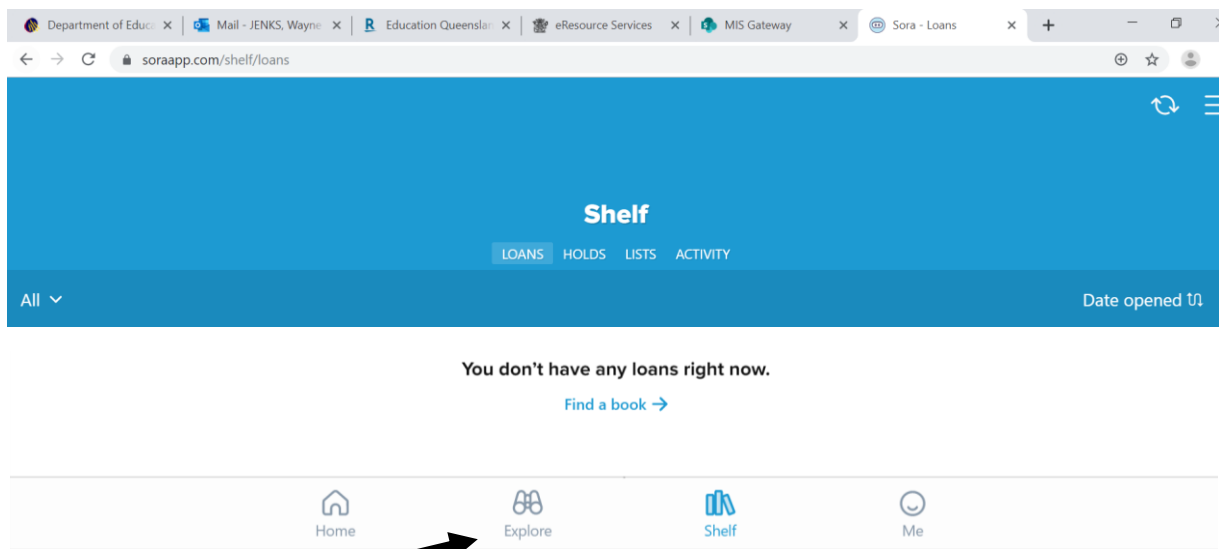
2. Locate your school – to borrow books we need to choose our school as **EDUCATION QUEENSLAND**



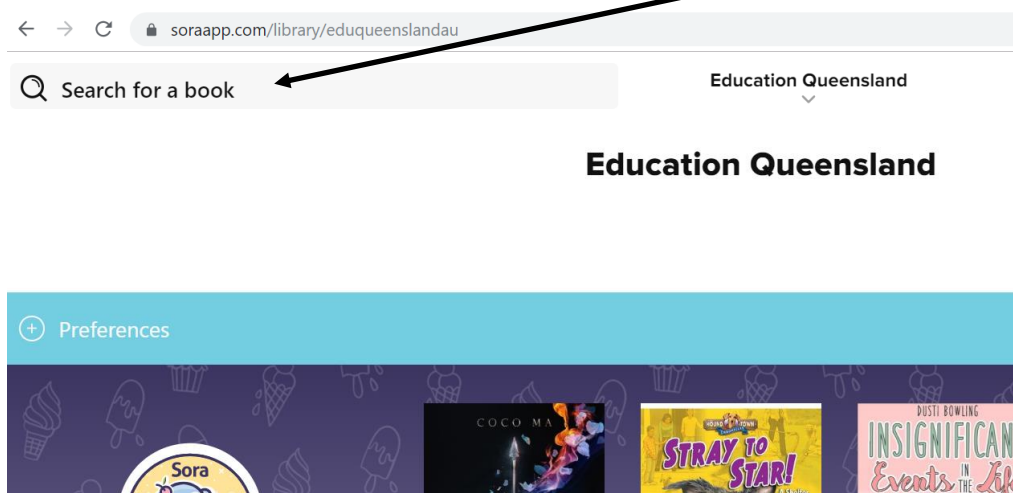
3. Sign in using your **MIS ID** – the one you use to access the Virtual Classroom



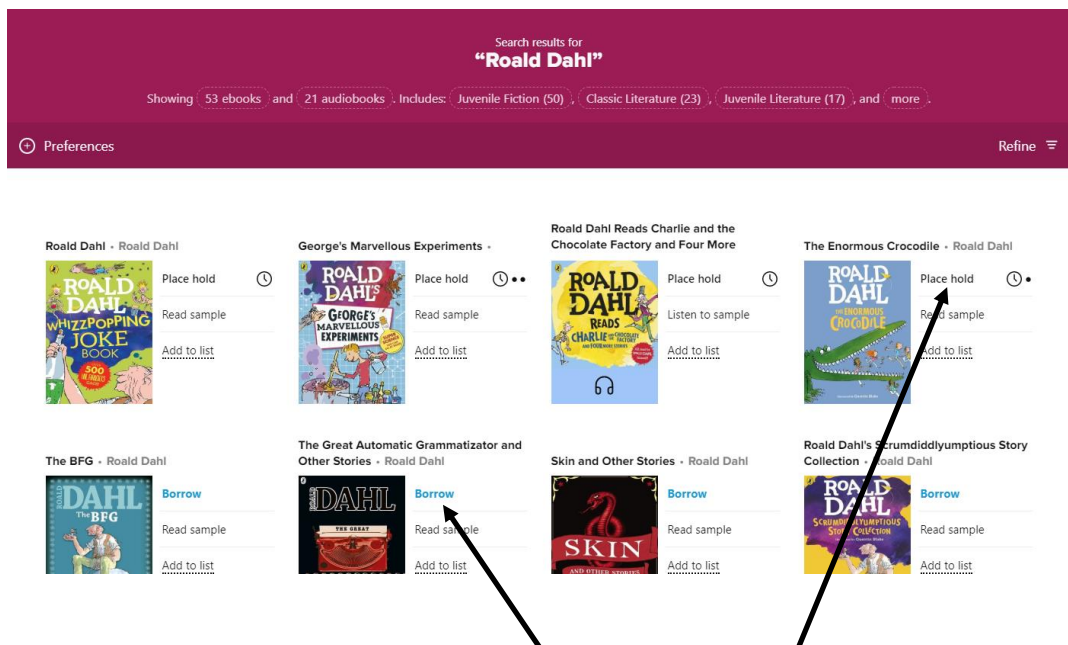
4. When you log in you will see your shelf – it will be empty as you will not have borrowed or returned any books



5. Click on **EXPLORE** – this will let you search by **TITLE**, **TOPIC** or **AUTHOR**



6. The sample below is what was found after entering "ROALD DAHL"



7. If the title is available you can click on BORROW

8. If somebody else has borrowed the book you can click on HOLD

How do I access the eBooks service on a mobile device?

- Install the free [Sora](#) app from either the APP Store or the PLAY Store
- Launch the Sora app
- Search for **Education Queensland** (in Sora)
- Log in with your Department username (MIS ID)
